Early Bird Registration

Both the registration form and complete payment must be sent in by May 31 to qualify for early bird pricing. Registrations and payments turned in after May 31 will cost \$135/person.

Opening Date February 1, 2010

Registrations will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis through July 7, 2010. Absolutely no new registrations will be accepted after July 7, 2010. The entire registration cost (including optional costs for t-shirt, transportation.) No refunds for t-shirts after May 31, 2010. Please note that registration will be open to churches outside Synod of the Heartland after April 30, 2010 depending on space availability.

Cancellations/Refunds

On or before May 31, 2010, a refund of \$60 will be issued for any Power Connection cancellation and/or \$40 issued for any PC Work Camp cancellation. NO REFUNDS will be given after May 31, 2010. NO REFUNDS for any transportation or t-shirt costs.

Substitutions

Substitutions are allowed for individual cancellations. However, after May 31, 2010, substitutions can ONLY be like gender (male for male or female for female). After July 7, 2010, NO SUBSTITUTIONS will be accepted due to the sanity of the Synod office personnel.

Adult/Student Ratio

Adults leaders are required at a minimum ratio of 1:7 (adult to student) per gender with the maximum ratio being 1:3 (adult to student). Adult leaders MUST be 18 years of age or older. All adult leaders are expected to spend time at each event with their students. It is the adult leaders who must enforce the Power Connection rules and guidelines within their own group.

Transportation

Groups attending both Power Connection and PC Work Camp must make their own travel arrangements. Travel options include booking your own charter bus, rental vans, or taking personal vehicles. However, for groups attending ONLY Power Connection, Synod transportation is available at an additional cost from select cities (chosen by the Synod) to be arranged by your youth pastor/leader.
