- may be asked to serve in a variety of different areas (registration, giving direction, security, crowd control, technical, concessions, etc) and must be willing to help whenever and wherever asked.
- are expected to be at Power Connection/PC Work Camp the entire time of the event (unless permission is otherwise granted). There will be busy times and slow times; everyone is expected to be there at all time to build community and be readily available as needs arise.
- for Power Connection are expected to be at Bethel University in St Paul, MN by 5:00pm on Thursday, July 29. PC Work Camp support staff is expected to be at Peace Reformed Church in Eagan, MN by 12:00pm (noon) on Tuesday, July 26.
- will be responsible for their own transportation to and from the event. The Synod will cover food, lodging, staff shirts, and activity tickets (eg. Valley Fair) while at the event.
- are expected to stay through clean-up on Sunday August 1. Youth groups are dismissed at 11:30am and depending on how fast clean-up goes, support staff should be dismissed shortly after (followed by the staff lunch).
