Opportunities of the Youth Director will include:

1. Lead and/or Support the Youth Group Ministry

- Junior High Youth Group
- Senior High Youth Group
- Special Events (Rocky Mt. High, Power Connection, and other outings)

2. Be Relational with Students and Parents

- Attend various school and community programs and events with a spirit of encouragement
- Keep in regular communication with the Consistory and Education Team to provide ministry updates

- Regular devotional time with God
